Completion of this application does not guarantee admission to the Academy of Future Educators. Determinations will be based on academic success in core curricula, student conduct and thorough review of this application and forthcoming interview, and the number of available spots in the Academy.

Student must acquire 200 hours of documented field experience and guided observations in grades PK - 12 in an educational setting while enrolled in the Principles of Teaching program. Field experience hours can be earned in a variety of settings, such as academic classrooms, CTE classrooms, ESE classrooms or an adult classroom. Students will have opportunities while in the program to earn those hours but may also need to earn hours (whether paid or unpaid) during summer break.

By completing the Academy of Future Educators (minimum of 3 courses completed), students may be eligible to earn a minimum of 12 college credits through articulation agreements with local colleges.

Students may have to pass a background screening and drug test, if required by agencies that a student will be working in.
